# **BACK TO THE FUTURE**

We joined our hearts together to **commit** to God and each other that this was only the beginning.

God spoke to WellSpring about becoming a people who are always praying and obeying. He clearly said to us that this 40 day season was a time He wanted to use in our church family's life, like a ZPAC (a turbo-antibiotic) or booster shot, to help us break out of places of mediocrity or complacency. Now, it's up to us to follow through and give ourselves to the Lord with the same intensity as we did during the last 40 days. Granted, not at the same pace. We can and must set our hearts toward the Lord and His ways with everything within us. Although it's going to look a little different than it did during our 40 Days of Breakthrough Prayer.
